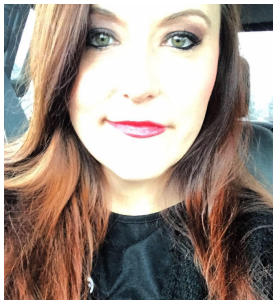

Camp hours are Monday, June 14th, through Friday, June 18th, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., culminating in a public performance of a popular teen musical on Friday evening, June 18th, at 7 p.m.

Camp applications must be postmarked by Wednesday, May 26, 2021, and mailed to TCBC, PO Box 5236, Union Springs, AL 36089 or hand-delivered to the Tourism Council office at 106 E.
